Please fast 8 – 12 hours for best results (drinking water is allowed).

- **CBC (Complete Blood Count):** White Blood Cells, Red Blood Cells, Platelet counts, Hemoglobin and Hematocrit
- **CMP (Complete Metabolic Panel):** 12 separate tests evaluating the kidney, liver, gallbladder, and heart.
Also includes blood sugar and electrolytes (potassium, sodium, chloride)
- **LIPID PROFILE:** Measures good and bad cholesterol (Total Cholesterol, HDL, LDL, and cardiac risk ratio).
- **GLYCOHEMOGLOBIN: (HbA1c)** Average blood sugar for the last 60 to 90 days.
- **TSH (Thyroid Stimulating Hormone)** regulate the way your body uses energy. It also plays an important role in regulating your weight, body temperature, muscle strength, and even your mood.
- **PSA (Prostate Specific Antigen)** is a significant marker in the early detection of prostate diseases (cancer in MALES ONLY).
- **Vitamin D:** To rule out Vitamin D deficiency. Vitamin D helps your body to absorb calcium and essential for the formation and maintenance of strong healthy bones.
- **Vitamin B12:** Necessary for DNA synthesis, normal red blood cell maturation and myelin sheath formation. Early diagnosis of Vitamin B12 deficiency is crucial because of the latent nature of this disorder and the risk of irreversible neurological damage.
